

Housing Co-ops Welcome New Initiative for Low-Income Households

The Co-operative Housing Federation of Canada (CHF Canada) welcomes yesterday's groundbreaking announcement of support for non-profit and co-operative housing under Manitoba's ALL Aboard poverty reduction strategy.

"CHF Canada congratulates the Manitoba government and Minister of Housing and Community Development Kerri Irvin-Ross for a landmark initiative that will protect hundreds of low-income households who rely on soon-to-expire assistance for part of their rents," said Karla Skoutajan, CHF Canada's Director, Sector Development.

Announced on June 9, the initiative will enable low-income households in Manitoba's 48 non-profit housing co-ops (housing over 7,000 Manitobans in some 2,800 mixed-income units) to maintain affordable rents.
