

National Housing Strategy Bill C400 at Second Reading

February 11, 2013

Bill C-400 is a private member's bill currently before Parliament that addresses the crisis of homelessness and inadequate housing in Canada. It calls for leadership on the development of a national housing strategy using a human rights framework. The Bill is currently at second reading in the House of Commons and will be referred to Committee - the crucial next step in the legislative process - if a majority vote is received. **Debate will take place on February 13, 2013 followed by a vote that is currently scheduled for February 27, 2013.**
