

Rooming House Assistance Program *for Information Sessions, see below*

The submission deadline for the Rooming House Assistance Program Call for Application is now extended to Thursday, June 30, 2016 at 4:00 pm. Landlords who have already submitted an application can contact Harnet Weldihiwet if they wish to alter their application.

The Rooming House Assistance Program (RHAP) is currently accepting applications. Funds are available to qualifying landlords for the repair of rooming houses. Qualifying landlords may receive up to \$25,000 per bed unit based on region and number of bed-units in the property if;

- They operate a rooming house having four or more Bed Units
- They have a legitimate landlord-tenant relationship as defined by the Residential Tenancies Act.
- The property is located in Manitoba outside of First Nations communities.
- The property is a minimum of five (5) years old.
- The rents are set at or below the Program Rental Limit for their area.
