

## Average rents and vacancy rate up: CMHC

According to the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) the vacancy rate continued to climb in the last six months, and is now at 1.2 percent. The vacancy rate increase is estimated even though the “rental universe” in Winnipeg lost 335 units over the past year.

The average rent for a 2 bedroom unit in Winnipeg climbed 5.4% in the past year and now sits at \$901.
