

# FCM 2011 Federal Election Platform

The Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM), in its Federal Election Platform, argues that “Canada’s housing system is broken and it’s time to implement a national action plan to fix it. All parties must commit to: (1) legislate 10-year targets for eliminating homelessness and fill housing market gaps so Canadians can find homes they can afford; (2) renew expiring federal housing programs and housing subsidies, and set dedicated funding levels for affordable housing in the long-term fiscal framework; and (3) provide incentives to increase the number of new rental units built across the country by 10 per cent each and every year.”
